Terms & Conditions

Provisional Bookings

The booking is provisional until the signed agreement/booking form is received along with the requested deposit. Should another client wish to book and confirm for the same date as your provisional booking, you will be asked to pay your remittance to confirm your booking within 48 hours. The Manor of Groves reserves the right to release your provisional booking if a deposit has not been received and confirmed within the 48 hour period.

Numbers

The minimum number of golfers for any society booking is twelve people.

Cancellation

In the event of a booking being cancelled by the Organiser, the deposit can be held for a rescheduled date with The Manor of Groves. Please note deposits are non refundable. If a society booking is cancelled 24 hours prior to event the full charge will be invoiced.

Payment

The Manor of Groves requires the full balance to be settled and confirmed number of players and menu no later than seven days prior to the event. Please be advised any shortfall in player numbers notified to us less than seven days prior to the event date will result in full payment being charged for the notified number of players. There will always be a minimum charge for twelve players.

Course Etiquette

The organiser is responsible for the group's standard of etiquette on both the Golf Course and within the Clubhouse. Failure to adhere to this may result in the individuals being asked to leave the course and the club. PLEASE ALLOW ONLY 13 MINUTES PER HOLE. IF YOU LOSE ONE HOLE FROM THE GROUP IN FRONT, YOU MUST ALLOW THE GROUP BEHIND YOU TO PLAY THROUGH. But preferably try to keep up with the game in front.

Dress Code

Whilst in the club and on the course, no swearing, loud or rowdy behaviour please. During the summer months if shorts are worn they must be tailored. No jeans, trainers, tracksuits or collarless/football/sports shirts. The dress code for the clubhouse is open and all we ask is our members and their guests to dress appropriately for the occasion. We regret that visitors to The Manor of Groves will not be allowed on the Course unless they are suitably attired. Golf shoes must have Soft Spikes (winter exceptions apply). Golfers must not share golf bags. Pagers or mobile phones must be on silent mode. Occasionally during the winter we implement a trolley ban. Please ensure that all players are aware of the etiquette of the game, e.g. pace of play – repairing pitch marks – replacing divots – dress code etc. At all times we would ask you to respect this policy. Management reserve the right to refuse admission to the Clubhouse or Course.

Course Closure

The Course may be closed at short notice due to bad weather conditions and at the discretion of the General Manager and Golf Director. The Manor of Groves will advise the Organiser as soon as possible, on the rare occasion that this may occur, the Organiser will be offered alternative dates. In the event of bad weather, pre booked buggies/trolleys may be cancelled.

Buggies

Buggies are to be paid for on arrival at the Club in the Professional Shop. In the event of damages the hirer will be liable for repair.

Liability

The Manor of Groves cannot accept responsibility or liability for loss or damage to personal belongings. Customers who wish to leave belongings on the premises do so at their own risk. For damage to property or injury to persons where such damage or injury occurs as a result of management negligence, Manor of Groves has public liability cover. It is the responsibility of the visitor to ensure that they have adequate cover to compensate for loss or damage to property in any other circumstances.

Course

Be on your starting tee 10 minutes before your tee time.

PLEASE BE AWARE – WE ALLOW 13 MINUTES PER HOLE so please ensure you are at your 10th hole within 2 hours of the start of your round.

IF YOU LOSE ONE HOLE FROM GROUP IN FRONT, YOU MUST ALLOW THE GROUP BEHIND YOU TO PLAY THROUGH. But preferably try to keep pace with the game in front.

At all times we would ask you to respect this policy, Management reserve the right to refuse admission to the Clubhouse or Course.

Competition Formats

Special Contests

Contests are an excellent way to get more mileage and fun out of your tournament. After all, everyone loves to win, and special event contests give everyone more opportunities to win. A beginner can win some of these contests, such as Closest to the Pin, as easily as by an expert player. Be aware: the more contests staged on the course during the tournament, the longer the tournament will take to play.

There are many different competitions to choose from here are just a couple of examples:

Longest Drive

A prize is awarded for the longest drive in the fairway. This is normally played on the course's longest par-5 hole.

Nearest the Pin

A prize is awarded for the shot that comes to rest closest to the pin. Normally, this is played at the course's first par-3 hole of the back nine.
